Hello ORSCNA Family!

Thank you for allowing me to be of service in the fellowship of Narcotics Anonymous.

On February 4th & 5th, I attended the Multi-Regional CAR (Conference Agenda Report) Workshop and MZF (Midwest Zonal Forum) Meeting that was hosted by the Michigan Region in Kalamazoo, MI.

At the CAR Workshop on Saturday, February 4th, app. 50 recovering addicts from the eight regions that comprise the Midwest Zone were in attendance. Facilitating the workshop was a member of the World Board and a staff person from NAWS (Narcotics Anonymous World Services). They presented a brief update on current Fellowship projects (e.g. the new Public Relations Handbook and revisions to the Basic Text), and announced the locations of future World Conventions:

2007	San Antonio, Texas	2009	Barcelona, Spain
2011	San Diego, California	2013	Philadelphia, Pennsylvania

Prior to discussion of the three Regional Motions in the CAR, the workshop facilitators pointed out that, as our Fellowship continues to develop an ability to conduct long-range planning in discussion-oriented/ consensus-building formats, it will be less likely for the World Board to recommend adoption of any Regional Motion that seeks to force a re-direction of WSC (World Service Conference) efforts.

Much of the discussion generated by the three Regional Motions was similar to discussion at our last RSC (Regional Service Committee) meeting. With regard to the motion from our Region, some of those in attendance wished that our motion included specific language for the proposed "Identity Statement." I reported that specific language had been removed from our original motions after discussion with various members of the World Board and NAWS personnel. Should similar comments be made at the WSC, we may want to be prepared to re-submit specific language in the form of an amendment to the motion.

The facilitators then led us through workshops on four of the five "Issue Discussion Topics" – "Atmosphere of Recovery"; "Leadership"; "Infrastructure"; and "Service Tools & Targeted Literature". I

noticed that as the day moved on, attendance at these workshops declined during the session breaks. By the end of the day, only 20-25 recovering addicts were still in attendance.

The MZF Meeting was held on Sunday, February 5th, at which we discussed the information that had been sent to Regions in the CAT (Conference Approval Track), including: the WSC 2006 Seating Report; the Area Planning Tool; the 2006-2008 NAWS Strategic Plan, Budget & Project Plans; and the Public Relations Handbook.

With regard to the Seating Report, there was no objection raised to the World Board's recommendations to approve seating of Iran, South Africa, or Western Russia. There was, however, considerable doubt & skepticism regarding the validity of statements made to justify seating of the two "break-away" regions – Bluegrass Appalachia and North Carolina – particularly in light of the Criteria for Recognition of New Conference Participants that was adopted by the WSC in 2000.

The Area Planning Tool was developed by NAWS and released by the World Board as a tool to assist all service bodies in providing more focused and effective services. Areas, regions & zones are encouraged to try this tool, or parts of it, and are asked to report our experience to NAWS.

The 2006 NAWS Strategic Plan, Budget & Project Plans are presented as a framework only, and are subject to modification at the WSC. Based on the discussion & input received, plan objectives & approaches may be changed, added, or deleted; and prioritizations may be adjusted.

As for the Public Relations Handbook, there was a considerable amount of concern regarding the fact that a final approval form of the entire PR Handbook will not be made available until the time of the WSC, thus offering no opportunity for review by the fellowship prior to the WSC. It is likely that the World Board will seek WSC approval for this new piece of service literature (which is allowable under WSC guidelines); however, departures from the normal course of business should be carefully considered. A suggestion offered by a member of the World Board is for a motion to be presented at the WSC to proceed with publication of the PR Handbook in a "pending approval" form so that it could be made available for use by the Fellowship while further review & editing is completed. A "finalized" form could then be presented for Fellowship approval in the 2008 CAR.

The next MZF meeting will be an informal gathering during the World Service Conference in Woodland Hills, CA in late April. This year's third quarterly meeting of the MZF is to be hosted by the Wisconsin Region on August 5th, and will be held in conjunction with their annual Unity Jam at Camp-Y-Koda in Sheboygan, WI. Then, the 2006 fourth quarterly meeting is to be hosted by the Chicagoland Region, followed by the 2007 first quarterly meeting in the Metro-Detroit Region.

My expenses for attending this CAR Workshop / MZF Meeting were as follows:

\$ 168.40	round trip airfare (Cincinnati, OH to Kalamazoo, MI)
70.72	overnight accommodations (half the cost of 2 nights at Clarion Hotel)
<u>10.50</u>	long-term parking at Greater Cincinnati Airport (half the cost)
\$ 249.62	total expenses incurred (2/3-2/5)

I am returning 38 cents to the Treasurer, which represents the balance of the \$250.00 advance received at the January RSC meeting. (Another \$40.00 or more was spent for meals and other incidentals; however, I consider those to be personal expenses of my choosing.)

Thanks to the input received from many of you in this meeting and others who are not present, I was able to compile & forward our Region's Report to the World Service Conference. This report is intended to present to the Worldwide Fellowship a brief description of the Ohio Region (our geographic location & size; and the number of areas, meetings, groups and H&I panels) and an overview of our service structure and the services we provide. A copy of this report was also forwarded to our Webmaster for posting on the Region's website.

On Saturday, March 4th, our Region conducted a Combined Workshop on the CAR (Conference Agenda Report) and CAT (Conference Approval Track). This workshop was hosted by COASCNA (the Central Ohio Area) at their Area Service Office in Columbus, OH. Twelve addicts from three areas, plus three others from outside the Region, were in attendance. We talked briefly about various ways to generate

interest and facilitate membership involvement in 'work-shopping' the "Issue Discussion Topics" within our local NA communities. This was followed by fairly extensive discussion of the three Regional Motions from the CAR, as well as the WSC (World Service Conference) 2006 Seating Proposals and the Criteria for Recognition of New Conference Participants from the CAT. Due to time constraints, we had virtually no opportunity to review & discuss the Strategic Plan for NA World Services or the more specific Budget Description & Project Plans; however, members were encouraged to review this information further and offer any suggested changes at the upcoming April RSC meeting.

My travel arrangements to attend the 2006 World Service Conference have been finalized, and round trip airfare was secured for \$255.20. I am returning \$44.80 to the Treasurer, which represents the balance of the \$300.00 advance received at the January RSC meeting for this expense. Since pre-conference activities will begin on Saturday morning (April 22nd), I plan to stay at the Conference hotel site (the Warner Center Marriott in Woodland Hills, CA) for nine nights (April 21st – April 29th) at the rate of \$56.48 per night (tax included) for a cost to the Region of \$508.32. Allowing another \$150.00 - \$200.00 for incidental expenses (such as ground transportation and special luncheon activities connected with the Conference), I will be requesting an advance from the RSC in the amount of \$700.00 to cover my remaining expenses for WSC 2006. (NOTE: The total actual cost for RDA travel to WSC 2004 was \$912.31.)

Zonal Forum Participation

The Ohio Region is becoming an active participant in the Midwest Zonal Forum.

About The Ohio Region

There are presently twelve areas in the Ohio Region, and a thirteenth area is in the formative stages. The geographic area served by the Region is roughly two-thirds of the state of Ohio, plus portions of northern Kentucky.

In cooperation with the Buckeye Region, which serves the groups in northeastern Ohio, we conduct H&I Panels in several of the State's correctional facilities. Periodically, we produce a State-Wide NA Meeting Directory for distribution to inmates within these facilities. This schedule includes all NA meetings within both the Ohio & Buckeye Regions, as well as NA meetings in two areas of the Tri-State Region (in eastern Ohio) and one area of the Mountaineer Region (in southeastern Ohio). In addition, we have jointly hosted NA Conventions "Behind The Walls" in some of the State's correctional facilities, and we are now planning to supply speaker tapes for use by inmates.

Collectively, the areas within the Ohio Region distribute nearly \$15,000 (in US dollars) worth of NA literature to H&I efforts each year.

Annual Donations and Expenses

Total expenses for the Ohio Region in 2005 were in excess of \$19,000.00. The sum total of donations from groups and areas to the Region in 2005 was around \$8,400.00. The cumulative total of donations from the Ohio Region to NAWS in 2005 was \$8,837.20.

Literature Distribution

At the present time, the Ohio Region does not maintain & operate a regional service office. Groups and areas within our region purchase NA literature from a variety of sources, including NA World Services and other regional service offices (RSO's). A few of our areas operate area service offices that make literature more readily available to local groups and members.

Regional Service Structure

The Ohio Regional Service Committee of Narcotics Anonymous is incorporated as a non-profit organization under the laws of the state of Ohio and, as such, is tax exempt.

We cooperate with the Buckeye Region to host OCNA, the annual "Ohio Convention of Narcotics Anonymous". Areas within the two regions take turns with the annual responsibilities for planning & hosting this statewide convention, which is traditionally held on the weekend preceding Memorial Day (the last weekend of May). This year's convention (OCNA XXIV) is being hosted by three areas of the Ohio Region and will be held in Mansfield, OH on May 26th, 27th & 28th. Average attendance at this event is app. 700. In an effort to improve the consistency of this event, our two regions have recently formed the Ohio Convention of Narcotics Anonymous, Inc., a non-profit corporation with a Board of Trustees to serve in an advisory & oversight capacity for each year's convention committee and serve as a liaison between these committees and both RSC's.

Four areas within the Ohio Region host area conventions, as follows:

- COACNA – "Central Ohio Area Convention of NA" – typically held on the first full weekend in January each year – average attendance is over 1,000;
- DACNA – "Dayton Area Convention of NA" – typically held on the fourth weekend of July every other year – average attendance is around 650;
- GCACNA – "Greater Cincinnati Area Convention of NA" – held on the weekend following Thanksgiving each year – average attendance is around 1,000; and
- TACNA – "Toledo Area Convention of NA" – typically held on the second full weekend in February each year – average attendance is over 500.

Additionally, the Ohio Region hosts the annual "12-Step Spiritual Retreat" on the second full weekend in October. This year's (the 17th annual) retreat will be held at Tar Hollow State Park, east of Chillicothe, OH, on October 13th, 14th & 15th. Last year, app. 350 addicts were registered for this event, nearly 600 addicts attended the Saturday night speaker meeting, and attendance continues to grow larger each year.

Our Region operates a toll-free NA helpline, the Ohio Info-Line, (1-800-587-4232). Calls are answered by a professional answering service that can provide the caller with information on local NA meetings and/or refer the caller to any one of five area-operated hotlines for further help. In some cases, the answering service refers messages to NA members serving as contacts for more specific information.

Also, the Ohio Region maintains a website (www.naohio.org) which provides contact information for each of the local Areas as well as for the Region (plus similar area & regional contact information for the Buckeye Region), internet access to NA meeting & activity information for the entire state (along with interactive mapping links for each meeting or event), direct links to the NA literature made available on the NA World Services website, and links to other NA-related websites. At last report, this website is receiving around 500 "hits" per week, and continues to exhibit increased interest & usage by NA members, professionals in the treatment of addictions, and other concerned individuals.

Recently, our Region has begun a project to place billboards at various locations around the state. The message highlights our Region's NA helpline and website and follows recommended Public Information guidelines. On a trial basis, two billboards have already been placed in eastern Ohio that resulted in increased helpline & website activity.

Innovations and Challenges

Since WSC 2004, the Ohio Region has shown continuous growth in the number of NA members, meetings and groups; and (now) a new area, serving several southeastern Ohio counties, is in the formative stages of development.

Probably the greatest challenge we face is attracting NA members to become (and remain) actively involved in service work. This is evidenced by vacant trusted servant positions and under-manned subcommittees, resulting in inactive subcommittees and inadequate or non-existent services.

Conference Input

As of the date of this report, the Ohio Region has not yet hosted any CAR workshops; however, our Delegate Team has attended the Multi-Regional CAR Workshop, hosted by the Michigan Region in conjunction with the quarterly meeting of the Midwest Zonal Forum on February 4th & 5th. Our Region will be hosting a CAR/CAT Workshop in Columbus, Ohio, on March 4th; and areas have been encouraged to host local workshops on the Issue Discussion Topics prior to our next RSC meeting in early April.

Treasurer

Hi Family. Addict named Terri, Regional Treasurer. We started out last quarter with \$3,728.90. We took in \$8,341.44 in donations and total expenses were \$5,231.04 leaving a balance of \$6,839.30. To my knowledge we no longer have a Vice-Treasurer. We need help.

Greetings Ohio Region,

All is well at naohio.org. I have seen a nice increase in the various areas getting updates and information about functions to the webmaster. Thank you! That is one of the biggest services that our regional website provides and it is great to see the areas putting it to good use.

However, as for the stuff I talked about last time, I must admit that I put school and work ahead of everything else these last few weeks and I procrastinated much of what I needed to get done for the website/region. I must apologize for that. So far, Spring Quarter at school will be quieter for me, and so I assure you all that I will take care of what is on my short list of things to do. So, other than keeping the functions updated, I've still got everything left to do. I will have it done long before the next RSC meeting. I will also send emails to all regional participants to update them as to the progress in getting these things accomplished.

These are the two BIG items on my To Do list from last Region that I intend to get finished before July:

(1) Online Meeting List

There is only one design we will work with on this project and it has already been test marketed in the M.E.A.S.C.N.A. Area with great success. When an Area decides on moving forward with this, they need to contact me either through e-mail or by phone to start the process. Once this is done I can order the poster or Vinyl and have it drop shipped to the Outdoor Advertiser or to the P.I. person direct. If the Area would like me to attend an Area Meeting to explain how this is going to work, I will make every effort to be there or at least supply detailed information to the process.

I am working on price lists, design and Outdoor Company listings in a small presentation file that can be emailed to Area Trusted Servants. Please be patient with me. This is really a huge undertaking and we would love to see this work. Building a good foundation and building a good relationship with this BIG OUTDOOR ADVERTISING COMPAINYS IS a MUST. They Don't need us – We NEED THEM. We are asking for ADVERTISING SPACE THAT THEY CAN SELL FOR BIG BUCKS. We would be paying a small posting fee and providing the posters to them in hopes that they will put them in GOOD locations. As the saying goes – We treat them good, they treat us good.
